Chapter 2.04

Sections:

2.04.10 Form of Government.

- A. The City government shall be organized in accordance with KRS 83A.030 (2) under the Mayor and Commission form of government.
- B. The City of New Haven, will elect on November 3, 1981 persons to fill the Offices of Mayor and four (4) Commissioners, who will assume office upon the taking of the oath on January 4, 1982. (Ord. 117, 1981)
- C. The City of New Haven elects to forego the conduct of a primary election for Nomination of candidates to city elective office, as provided in KRS 83A.045.
- D. All candidates for city elective offices shall file their nomination papers with the Nelson County Clerk not less than sixty-eight (68) days before the day fixed for the regular elections by KRS Chapter 118. (Ord. 385 Series 2005)

2.08.010 Compensation of Commissioners. The compensation of the commissioners of the city is fixed at seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) annually. Payments are to be made annually. (Ord. 353 #2, 2002: Ord. 321 #1, 1998: Ord. 193 #1, 1993)

208.020 Compensation of Mayor. The compensation of the mayor of the city is fixed at two thousand and five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) annually. Payments are to be made annually. (Ord. 353 Series, 2002; Ord. Series 1998; Ord. 194 Series 1993)

208.030 Board of Commissioners Meetings. The meeting time and day shall be the third Thursday of each month at six P.M. (Ord. 402 Series 2007; Ord. 370 Series 2004; Ord. 343 Series 2000; Ord. 195 Series, 1993)
