Tessie reported that the **Nelson County Fiscal Court designated an extra \$250.000.00 in ARPA Funds** to the City of New Haven to help re-direct the waste water treatment plant affluent discharge from David Run Creek to the Rolling Fork River. This makes a total of \$450,000 that the city will receive in ARPS funds from the NC Fiscal Court. A memorandum of agreement and contract was signed by Mayor Cecil and Judge Executive Nicky Rapier.

The New Haven Christmas Parade and several other events will be held on Sunday, December 4, 2022.

Fred DeWitt informed the Board of Commissioners that he was interested in **filling the vacant seat** on the board in 2023. Ruth mentioned that Dooley Mattingly was also interested. A decision will be made in the January 2023 meeting on who will fill the seat.

Fred DeWitt reported that the **merge agreement** is being reviewed by the Attorney General's Office. We hope to get approval from them to proceed very soon.

Linda will be setting up a meeting with **Kenvirons** to find out when we will be advertising for bids to begin the project.

The **sale of the water system** has been approved by the PSC. The tentative date of transfer is still 12/15/2022. Larue County Water is working with Rural Development to pay off the city's sewer loans.
