Present were the following: Mayor Linda Mattingly, Commissioner Lois Boley, Commissioner Fred DeWitt, Commissioner Ruth Faulkner and Commissioner Morris.

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 PM.

The **Meeting Minutes of December 18, 2025** were approved on motion of Commissioner Boley and second of Commissioner Morris. All voted in favor. Motion Carried.

### **Street Department**

Mayor Mattingly informed the board that LTADD visited New Haven to look at North Main Street to see if it was even possible to install sidewalks. He said that was and that the city has an 80-foot easement on North Main Street. Charles and his assistant Ava have submitted an application for a TAP grant to cover the planning and designing portion of this project. If awarded it will be an 80/20 grant (City will pay 20% and the Grant will cover 80%). Mayor Mattingly mentioned that the city would have a public hearing for all residents to discuss the idea of installing the sidewalks.
