BUSINESS LICENSES GENERALLY

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- 5.04.030 Term of license--Payment of tax.
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- 5.04.050 Disposition of funds.
- 5.04.060 License fee schedule.

- 5.04.010 License required. Within the corporate limits of the city, it is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to engage in any trade, occupation, or profession, or to sell or offer for sale any articles of goods, wares, or merchandise named in this chapter or any section thereof without first having procured a license to do so and pay the required tax thereof. (Ord. dated 3/9/96 §1)
- 5.04.020 Application. A. Every person desiring to obtain a city license for any of the businesses enumerated in this chapter shall apply for a certificate therefore to the city clerk, and the person to whom the license certificate shall be issued shall pay to the city clerk the required license tax. The possession of the duly issued license shall be prima facie evidence of the fact that the license tax has been duly paid.
- B. Notwithstanding any provision contained in this chapter, any applicant for the city license under the provisions of this chapter for any occupation, profession, or business, shall provide evidence for any certification,

license, or permit required by federal, state, or county for the conduct of said occupation, profession, or business prior to issue of any license by the city.

C. All applicants for city license occupying buildings classified, as "Assembly" under the Kentucky Building Code shall submit evidence of a temporary certificate of occupancy issued by the Kentucky Department of Building and Housing Requirement, prior to obtaining such license. If a permanent Certificate of Occupancy is not issued prior to the renewal date of such license, the city shall not issue a renewal city license. (Editorially amended during 1996 codification; Ord. 5.040.030 Term of license—Payment of tax.

- All licenses granted and issued under this chapter shall be due by July 1st of each year, and all licenses issued under this chapter shall expire June 30th of each year succeeding the date said license is issued, except as hereinafter specified. Except in the case of occupations, trades and professions, as to which provision is made, license shall be issued and license tax paid for a pro rata portion of a year if the applicant was not in business on July 1st of that year; provided however, that no license fees or tax shall be pro rated for less than ten dollars (\$10.00).
- B. All licenses required by this chapter shall be issued by the city clerk, and all fees required shall be payable to said officer. (Ord. Dated $3/9/1996 \sim 3$)
- 5.04.040 Delinquent payment of tax. Any and all license fees or taxes due to be paid July 1st and not paid by that time shall be assessed a penalty of ten percent of the fee or tax required for that particular business, occupation, or profession, for each month delinquent, but not to exceed a total of fifty (50) percent of the fees or taxes required for the particular business, occupation, or profession. The penalty, together with regular tax or fee shall be paid before license is issued. If a license fee is not paid by August 15th of current fiscal year billing period, operation of the business will be discontinued until such time as payment is made in full for delinquent business license(s). - 5.04.050 <u>Disposition of funds.</u> All revenue received from payment of license fees and penalties by this chapter shall be paid into and become part of the general fund of the city to be used for the general operating expenses or any special interest beneficial to the city. (Ord. Dated 3/9/1996 ~5)
- 5.04.060 <u>License fee schedule.</u> Each person, firm or corporation owning, operating, conducting or engaging in any of the following occupations, businesses, trades, or

professions, whether such occupation, business, trade or profession be operated or conducted separately or in connection with another occupation or business shall pay the amount of license tax set; said amount designating a full year's license unless otherwise specified.

Alcoholic Beverages

(1) Beer Retailers and Distributors.

For the purpose of this schedule, "beer" shall be construed to include within its meaning only beer, lager beer, ale, stout, or similar fermented malt liquor, or fruit juice containing not less than 3.2% of alcohol by weight. This license shall be issued only by the board of commissioners. All ordinances now in force regarding the regulation of establishments granted a license under this subsection, and the revocation of that license, shall remain in full force and effect, and reference is made to those ordinances to have the same effect as if the regulations were embodied herein.

Home Occupations: Professional offices, studios, and personal services maintained or conducted within a dwelling. Neither the selling of any merchandise nor processing of any product shall qualify as a home occupation. Home occupation includes only those which meet the following performance:

- (1) Home occupations shall be incidental to the principle residential use, occupying no more than twenty-five (25) percent of the total floor area of a dwelling.
- (2) Home occupations shall result in no exterior evidence excepting a permitted sign that the dwelling is used for a nonresidential use.
- (3) Home occupations shall not generate any atmospheric pollution, light flashes, glare, odors, noise, vibration, or truck or other heavy equipment traffic.

<u>5.04.070 Penalty.</u> Except as otherwise specifically provided in this chapter, any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than three times the normal license fee that the person, firm or corporation continues the violation shall constitute a separate offense.

No license shall be issued to any business/entitiy until all state and/or county regulations are met as required by law. This refers to any business that is required to have permits/licenses from the state of Kentucky or Nelson County before operating said buinsess. (Ord. Dated 3/9/96 ~7; Ord. 412 Series 2009
